TECH CAMP

TechCamp@POLIMI is the first project in Italy to bring high school students closer to technological courses with university-level standards. It was born from the idea of two professors of Politecnico di Milano it is a novelty in the numerous initiatives of orientation of the university to establish new "bridges" between technical universities and high schools. The goal is to offer young secondary school students a brief course to explore the theory, but above all to experiment with particularly relevant, up-to[1]date technological subjects, starting with robotics, self-driving vehicles and coding. The primary purpose is not to necessarily lead to university studies in engineering, but it is above all to make known to young people, who may choose other paths in life, the scientific basis of some of the most important technological issues of the future years. The courses are in English and are taught by teachers, researchers and PhD students of Politecnico di Milano.

SPORT PROMOTION AND EVENTS

Sport activities are an unique opportunity for students to come together, increasing their sense of belonging, stimulating competition and building self-esteem. For this reason Politecnico di Milano is committed to continuously enriching its sport offer and sporting events organization. Three main sport events are held throughout the year: PolimiRun Winter, held around the Lecco Campus, PolimiRun Spring, held in Milan, connecting the two city Campuses, and PolimiRide, a cycling event that tours among the four Campuses located outside the city of Milan. All events are open to all citizens and represent an occasion for strengthening the relationship between the university communities located in the different cities where Politecnico is present. In order to improve socialization and health through sport within the university community, the university organizes yearly students championships of 5-a-side Football, Volleyball, Basketball, Padel and Athletics; a hundred teams take part annually, with a total of over 1,000 students.

SPESA SOSPESA A NOLO

The “Spesa Sospesa a Nolo” is a solidarity initiative in support of the Nolo neighbourhood's inhabitants, conceived during the first lockdown following the Covid-19 pandemic. Created within the “Nolo Social District”, the neighbourhood's social street, since October 2020 it has been managed by OFF CAMPUS Nolo where 20 items of shopping are distributed weekly to vulnerable people thanks to donations from citizens. As well as calling for greater attention to be paid to the economically disadvantaged groups affected by temporary unemployment situations aggravated by the pandemic, the initiative also supports the economy of small neighbourhood shops by purchasing their products. Off Campus Nolo is located in an indoor market in Viale Monza 53, Milan. Spesa Sospesa a Nolo is an initiative for people in temporary economic difficulty and the collaborative spirit of the neighbourhood and its inhabitant goes beyond the management of the initiative, helping the Off Campus Nolo community also in the promotion of the initiative outside the Viale Monza Municipal Market.

The programme has the aim of stimulating cooperation and inclusion processes in vulnerable contexts, developing innovative technologies, processes and services to reduce social inequalities, and consolidate research and co-design in collaboration with other university departments and/or external stakeholders

The 2023 edition “Activating Communities, Bridging the Gaps” is designed in close relationship with the “Off Campus – Il Cantiere per le Periferie” University project. The funded projects will strive to frame situations of unbalance and need within the contexts of intervention, with a view to extending and renewing the community service function offered through the Off Campus hubs network.
