

Dear Student,

as recently anticipated by our Rector, starting from next semester all lessons will return to take place regularly in presence.

It is important to know, in this regard, that from next September 1st, the Green Pass will be required to access all university facilities. Furthermore, since last August 6th, the Green Pass is also required to access indoor restaurants, gyms, swimming pools, spas and other places at risk of crowding, such as cinemas, theaters, concert halls, stadiums or sports halls. The Green Pass is also required for events, conferences and congresses.

The Green Pass certifies one of the following conditions:

- ${f \cdot}$  having completed the prescribed anti-SARS-CoV-2 vaccination course since at least 14 days  ${f ^*}$
- be **cured** of COVID-19 (the validity of the healing certificate is 180 days from the date of the first positive swab)
- having made a **molecular or antigenic swab** in the **48 hours prior** to entering the facility with a negative result (in this case, the Green Pass is valid for 48 hours only)
- \* in Italy, the Green Pass is issued 12 days after the first dose (in the case of vaccines that require administration in two doses), and is valid from the 15th day after the vaccine until the date of the second dose. Afterwards, it is released within 2 days from the second dose, and is valid for 9 months.

Currently, the following vaccines have been authorized in Italy:

- Pfizer-BioNtech Comirnaty vaccine
- Spikevax vaccine (Moderna)
- AstraZeneca Vaxzevria vaccine
- Janssen vaccine (Johnson & Johnson)

If you have been vaccinated with a vaccine not currently recognized in Italy, please wait for further updates.

In order to book an appointment for the vaccine, you will need the Health Insurance Card, if you already have one, or the Fiscal Code (tax code). If you still do not have a tax code, you can obtain a temporary code to book the appointment, by calling from Italy, and from a mobile phone, the toll-free number 800894545 (selection 1, post selection 3), only if you are planning to be vaccinated in Lombardy.

In particular, we have been assigned a reference vaccination hub located at Fabbrica del Vapore, via G. Procaccini 4, Milan.

Further information and full list of vaccination hubs are available on the portal, which is also accessible for students from our Regional Campuses.
