Description

Founded in 1888 by the archbishop of Santiago, the Pontificia Universidad Católica de Chile (UC) has a consolidated tradition.

The Design Department was founded in 1967, and since then, the university has grown to have more than 30,000 students enrolled and become the most prestigious university in Latin America according to QS Ranking 2020.

50 years after its formation, the Design Department also consolidates its university character, successfully transitioning from teaching to research through the entry of professors with postgraduate and doctorate degrees.

Strengths

- The Campus environment, located in the central area of Santiago, is lively and international, and yet the relationship with professors is facilitated by the relatively small size of study groups in the classroom and design works in the studio.
- The facility of the School of Design includes experimentation rooms, auditoriums, computer labs, analog/digital prototypes, and specialties such as textile design, lighting, new media and photography. In addition to this, it has a library of the highest level.
