

ESAIL - Ecole Supérieure d'Architecture Intérieure de Lyon (Jean Cottin)

Description

ESAIL was founded in 1984 by Jean Cottin, a registered architect (DPLG) and a former student of noted architect and city planner Tony Garnier. The main building houses 17 higher-education establishments that share different facilities like: The school of architecture and interior design in Lyon, which also offers its training as an interior designer in Bordeaux, puts practice at the heart of its pedagogy.

Throughout the training, the students carry out concrete projects that allow them to apply what they learn in class. ESAIL maintains relations with the profession by inviting practitioners to give lectures, at the end of each year and school exercises with real-world customers.

Strengths

- Students have their own computer lab. Freely accessible outside of normal class times, the lab has workstations that run CADD software (AutoCAD, Allplan, Artlantis, Photoshop, Cinema4D) and a colour printer (A4, A3, and A2 size documents).
- Students have also acess to specific rooms equipped with video projectors, drawing tables, easels, work storage areas, a model room equipped with a laser cutting machine.
