

INTERNATIONAL MOBILITY CONTRIBUTIONS A.Y. 2024/2025

On June 25th, 2024, the Board of Directors of the Politecnico di Milano resolved the criteria for the allocation of contributions for International Mobility for the a.y. 2024/2025.

Following you find the table of contributions, which is defined on the basis of two criteria:

- amount of the ISEE value (or the so called "ISEU Parificato"), if submitted by the student, for years 2024 or 2023. If presented in both years, the most recent ISEE will be taken into consideration. It is important that the ISEE is submitted and accepted at the time of the preparation of the mobility contract, because once the contributions are defined, they cannot be changed following the submission of a new ISEE.
- Country of destination, according to the subdivision defined by the Erasmus Commission as regards the Countries participating the programme, based on the cost of living in the host Country. The Politecnico di Milano then equates non-European Countries with European Countries with higher cost of living.

The monthly amounts shown above are allocated as follows: Mobility for study: up to a <u>maximum</u> of 5 months Double Degree and Medes project: up to a <u>maximum</u> of 10 months

PLEASE KEEP IN MIND THAT

The actual amount of the contribution for mobility is recalculated on the return of each student, based on his actual stay abroad for study purposes, certified by the documents he will provide (final confirmation letter and document of trip of arrival and departure). As a result, the last instalment can be different from what was initially provided for in the mobility contract.

It is also important to keep in mind that in order to maintain the right to contribute, upon their return students must have:

- passed at least one exam attended abroad, that has to be validated in the study plan;

- carried out his research/thesis activity.

otherwise, student must refund the full amount of the contribution paid/assigned.

In any case a partial or total refund of the contribution is required, and until the refund is actually paid, the student cannot:

- graduate;
- transfer to another university;

- withdraw from studies.

We strongly recommend the students to carefully read the mobility agreement, in particular articles 3, 4 and 10.
