ART. 1 FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS

The Art. 3 of the Call for assignment of Financial Aid Benefits A.Y. 2023/2024 – issued by the Management Decree Ref. 130297/2023 (hereinafter also “*the Call*”), is supplemented as follows:

ISEE/ISEEU Parificato and ISPE/ISPEU limits

Students requesting Financial Aid Benefits (hereinafter also “*DSU benefits*”) should have:

- an ISEE/ISEEU Parificato (issued for the sake of obtaining “*benefits for the right to higher education*”) not higher than **€ 24.335,11**;
- an ISPE/ISPEU calculated by dividing the ISP value (Assets Status Indicator provided by INPS) by the equivalency scale, not higher than **€ 52.902,43**.

Regardless of their merit, students whose ISEE/ISEEU Parificato or ISPE/ISPEU exceeds the abovementioned limits will be excluded from the assignment of DSU benefits.

Independent student

A student is defined as “independent” when the following requirements are met conjunctly:

- The student has had a different and separate residence from their family’s one for at least two years from the subscription of the Dichiarazione Sostitutiva Unica, and such a residence is not located in a property owned by their family;
- The student has been perceiving for two years an own, fiscally declared income derived from an employment relationship or assimilated no lower than **€ 9.000,00**. Such activities must not be carried out under an individual who is bonded to the student through kinship. If the independent student, basing on their civil status certificate, is cohabiting with another person, the incomes of both people must be considered mandatorily, even if they are not relatives.

ART. 2 DSU SCHOLARSHIPS: NUMBER AND VALUE

Art. 13 of the Call is supplemented as follows: there are **4.300** DSU scholarships available, divided up as below:

Students enrolled in the first year of Bachelor of Science programs or single-cycle Master of Science programs	430
Students enrolled in the first year of Master of Science programs	1.250
Students enrolled in the first year of PhD and specialisation courses	10
Students enrolled in subsequent years of all study programs	2.600
Students enrolled in subsequent years of PhD and specialisation courses	10

Income brackets

The income brackets through which DSU Scholarship amounts are determined are the following:

Scholarship amounts based on student's income brackets and geographical origin

The DSU scholarship's amounts, considering both the income bracket and student's geographic origin, are determined as follows:

Local student	
1 st bracket	€ 2.415,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 3.185,00
2 nd bracket	€ 2.007,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 2.777,00
3 rd bracket	€ 1.220,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 1.990,00

Commuter student	
1 st bracket	€ 3.705,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 4.475,00
2 nd bracket	€ 3.121,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 3.891,00
3 rd bracket	€ 2.293,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 3.063,00

Away from home student housed in Politecnico di Milano residences	
1 st bracket	€ 4.288,00 + housing + one free meal per day for a total of € 7.656,00
2 nd bracket	€ 3.289,00 + housing + one free meal per day for a total of € 6.657,00
3 rd bracket	€ 2.069,00 + housing + one free meal per day for a total of € 5.437,00

Away from home student housed in other accommodations, either public or private	
1 st bracket	€ 6.886,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 7.656,00
2 nd bracket	€ 5.887,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 6.657,00
3 rd bracket	€ 4.667,00 + one free meal per day for a total of € 5.437,00

For students enrolled in the academic year 2023/2024 who are beneficiary of DSU for their additional term of all courses and students enrolled in the first year of Master of Science courses starting from the second term, the amount of their scholarship, as well as their services' deductions, will be reduced by 50%.

Students with certified disability of 66% or higher can get the annual amount of their scholarship increased up to 40% on top of the one they are entitled to, for a final benefit amounting to a maximum of:

€ 4.459,00 for local students
€ 6.265,00 for commuter students
€ 10.719,00 for away from home students

ART. 3 SCHOLARSHIP'S INCREASE ex DM 1320/2021

For female students enrolled in study courses related to STEM subjects (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) the amount of their scholarship is increased by 20% (art. 3, c.5 of DM 1320/2021). Such an increase is not cumulative with the one by 15% reserved for students with an ISEE level lower by 50% than the maximal limit of reference (art. 3, c. 3, of DM 1320/2021). Thus, for female students classified in the first and second bracket, it is calculated by taking into consideration the amount of the scholarship reserved for the second income bracket, whereas for female students classified in the third bracket it is calculated by taking into consideration the amount of the scholarship reserved for the third income bracket.

ART. 4 CANTEEN SERVICE DEDUCTION

Art. 19 of the Call is supplemented as follows:

a **deduction** equal to € 770,00 will be made from the amount of the DSU scholarship. The first 50% will be deducted from the first instalment of DSU scholarship, whilst the remaining 50% will be deducted from the second instalment.

Assigned students enrolled in the Online School of Engineering of Computing Systems may request for the abovementioned deduction not to be made. This request must be submitted by

no later than **December 20th 2023** exclusively through the email¹ address indicated on www.polimi.it/diritto-allo-studio (select: *Canteen Service*).

Submissions sent after the deadline and/or through a different channel than the indicated one will not be considered.

ART. 5 ACCOMMODATION DEDUCTION FOR STUDENTS HOUSED IN POLITECNICO DI MILANO'S RESIDENCES

Art. 29 of the Call is supplemented as follows:

a **deduction** equal to € 2.643,00 will be made from the amount of the scholarship for students housed in Politecnico di Milano's residences.

ART. 6 CORRECT MERIT REQUIREMENTS' DETERMINATION

The content of Art. 4.3 of the Call is modified as follows:

ECTS must:

- result regularly registered on the study plan on the date of their verification;
- belong to the study plan of the study course² for which DSU benefits are required.

The following ECTS are not considered for the calculation of the overall grade nor for the one of the achievement of the minimal academic merit:

- Extra ECTS;
- Single courses ECTS;
- ECTS constituted by multiple modules which do not allow the registration of the final grade on the study plan up until all their parts are completed with a positive outcome;
- ECTS related to the final project or similar.

ART. 7 ACCUMULATION

Art. 12.1 accumulation and exceptions is modified as follows:

the DSU scholarship is not cumulable with analogue forms of economic aid issued by the managing Subject or by other public or private Entities.

Exception is made:

- For Scholarships offered by national or foreign Institutions, which aim to integrate through overseas' stays the education and research activity of their beneficiaries;
- For the prizing contribution assigned by Universities to students enrolled in programmes of excellence.

² For instance, ECTS related to courses of the catalogue *Passion in Action* or similar are not considered.

If a student is assigned the DSU Scholarship whilst also be awarded with another non-cumulable scholarship simultaneously, they will have to choose which one to accept, by exercising the right of option

In particular, if the student opts for the other scholarship - i.e. not the DSU Scholarship - they must notify, by 10 days from accepting the non-DSU Scholarship, the Financial Aid Unit via the email channel indicated on the webpage: www.polimi.it/diritto-allo-studio > (select: DSU scholarship).

If the incompatibility is spotted automatically, this constitutes grounds for forfeiture of the DSU benefit and will subsequently preclude the student from exercising the right of option³.

The DSU Scholarship does not preclude participation in Calls for paid student collaborations.

ART. 8 REFERRAL


It shall be without prejudice to the provisions of the Call emanated with Management Decree ref. 130297 as of June 5th 2023.
